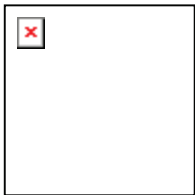

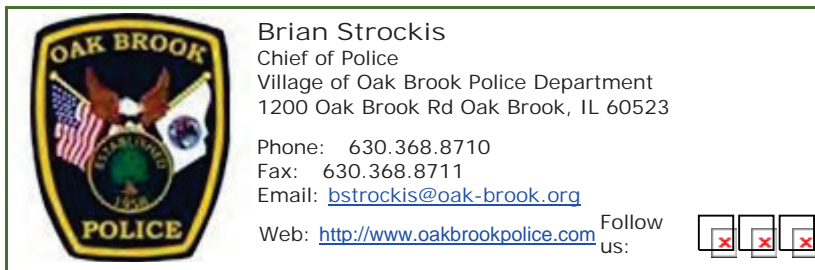



Attorney General Kwame Raoul is pleased to announce another round of grant funding, in the amount of \$5,000,000.00, for the Organized Retail Crime program is available.

The application is available by clicking the link below. If your agency has an active AmpliFund account, sign in and click Apply when the application appears. The link will prompt you to create an account, if one does not exist.

A Letter of Intent is not required for FY24. The application period is July 1, 2023 through August 31, 2023. All applications must be submitted by August 31, 2023. The grant period is from July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024. This allows agencies more time than was available for FY23 to plan, receive approvals, and expend the funds. The rules and guidelines are unchanged from FY23, with the exception of the Letter of Intent. Multi-year service contracts for equipment, software, and maintenance are allowed, however, only one year of funding for the contract is allowable.

ORGANIZED RETAIL CRIME FUNDING PRIORITIES

Funding Purposes

ORC funding is intended to:

- 1) Enhance law enforcement collaboration in combatting organized retail crime;
- 2) Enhance ongoing investigations of organized retail crime;
- 3) Provide training to law enforcement and prosecutors in the investigation and prosecution of organized retail crimes;
- 4) Support overtime for law enforcement in investigations of organized retail crime in both the home agency of officers and in collaboration with the Attorney General's Organized Retail Crime Task Force.

Application Process

Allowable categories for funding include:

- 1) Training requests:**
 - Provide the name, dates and location of the proposed training
 - The number of people to be trained
 - How the training will enhance the agencies ORC capabilities
- 2) Overtime Request –Home agency:**
 - Explain the reason overtime is necessary
 - Status of the current investigation
 - How the overtime will assist in moving the investigation forward
- 3) Overtime request-Attorney General's Task Force Embed:**
 - Explain the reason overtime is necessary
 - Status of the current investigation
 - How the embedded officer will assist in moving the investigation forward and how the collaboration will assist in reducing organized retail crime.
 - Define any specific skills the embedded officer will bring to the Attorney General's Task Force
- 4) Equipment**
 - List requested equipment including the number of units, placement, and intent of use.
 - List any software license /equipment maintenance under Contractual in the Budget
 - Only one year of software license /equipment maintenance is eligible for funding.
- 5) Specific Investigation grants**
 - Provide as much detail as legally permissible, as outlined in the application. Specifics of the investigation may warrant a conversation with the ORC committee.

IMPORTANT DATES

Term of Grant: July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024

Submit application: July 1, 2022 – August 31, 2022

FUNDING PRIORITIES

The Administrator shall consider the following factors in determining whether and how much to fund a given applicant:

1. The extent to which the applicant's stated goals are consistent with the purpose enumerated in Section 1-15 of the Illinois Integrity, Notification, and Fairness in Online Retail Marketplaces Act. The commitment and ability to provide the services for which funding is sought. Evidence of commitment and ability includes: programmatic expertise (i.e., qualifications, training, including in-service training for staff, and experience of agency staff), and the level of resources available to the program.
2. The number of people served, types of services provided, and needs of the community as described in the grant application;
3. Evidence of collaborative support exhibited by the grant application between law enforcement and prosecution partners;
4. The organizational structure of the agency;
5. The OAG grant review committee shall compare and contrast the applicants' proposed initiatives to determine which applicants in a given geographic area are best able to develop ORC Investigations, trainings or provide law enforcement support on the OAG's taskforce or provide specialized skills or intelligence that will be beneficial to ongoing Organized Retail Crime Investigations across the state;
6. The OAG grant review committee shall select applicants so as to increase the number of ORC investigations statewide as well as to provide opportunities for specialized services and training;
7. Grants will be made for a term of one year corresponding to the State's fiscal year, unless the Administrator determines that a shorter term is appropriate.

Reporting Requirements

- 1) **For training grants:** Submit proof of training along with receipts for payment of the training, travel, and other related expenses within 30 days of the completion of the training.
- 2) **For Overtime grants:** Submit proof of payments and a brief narrative summary of the results of the overtime by July 15, 2024.
- 3) **For Overtime Request-Attorney General's Task Force Embed:** A review of the progress of the investigation will occur 60 days after the start date of the grant. All receipts for awarded expenses are due by July 15, 2024.
- 4) **For Equipment grants:** Submit receipts, purchase orders, or contracts by July 15, 2024.
- 5) **For Specific Investigation grants:** A review of the progress of the investigation will occur 60 days after the start date of the grant. All receipts for awarded expenses are due by July 15, 2024.

All grantees must submit a brief narrative performance report on the outcomes of the requested activity/equipment. Include number of arrests, number of people trained, number of units of equipment and placement, or progress of an investigation.

Good morning!

No problem with the follow up and future updates. I read Matt's update the same way you did so I didn't ask the right questions before we posted the monthly report for the meeting.

FUSUS is one of the first ones out of the box and we've been chasing it because Oak Brook purchased before we knew they were doing this so we weren't prepared. New chief's don't always know all of the policies in place.

The MOU language is with the States Attorney and Mark Winistorfer hopes to have something this week to go to the agencies. There are multiple agencies interested so that adds to the language (if we want to help our community partners in their cost sharing). Mark and I also talked about adding a letter of intent to the policy which would allow us to move a little faster. I realize that doesn't help with this project but sometimes we just don't know until we get there. That's the reason why we told the board the policy would probably go through some adjustments.

Paperwork aside, since Hexagon was willing to work on this "at risk" (meaning without a signed document) so we are still moving along behind the scenes. They are willing to do this because the ETSB is a solid customer with a good track record of payment and partnership. We just don't advertise that because I don't want every agency to assume that this will happen because its not always possible. And I am hoping that once we get these issues ironed out with these first few requests it would be unnecessary.

Timeline: Let's see what Mark comes up with. If we get a letter of intent, we can move forward while we wait for the MOU to go through the process if the interface is ready before the MOU comes back. On thing to keep in mind, the SAO wants MOUs, IGAs, and agreements signed by authorized parties. That usually means at a Village Board meeting for police. That's why we talked about the Letter of Intent.

It would also be grand if the SAO only had a few things on their plate, but as you know there have been several things happening that jump in front on a matter like this. Mark indicated he would work on it over the weekend, so I am hopeful for this week.

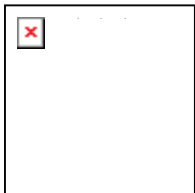

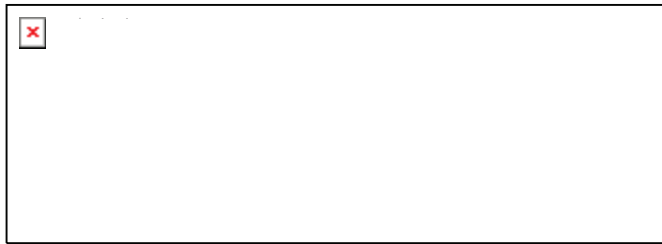

1. Do we have a timeline for when Hexagon will provide the scope of work for the Tech Focus Group to review? This is solely for the FUSUS interface for Oak Brook, correct? Or is this for future scaling of the interface so other communities can interface with Hexagon?
2. It was stated that “Hexagon is also reviewing the possibility of a generic Edge Frontier interface that can be built so that future vendors/agencies can connect without needing to engineer an entirely new interface. Hexagon to provide a cost for the interface configuration and development.” Again, are we talking about the interface with FUSUS for Oak Brook or will the FUSUS interface for Oak Brook be configured now such that future vendors/agencies can interface with Hexagon?

Subject: Edge Frontier Interface Update

Summary:

Request: Oak Brook Police submitted an interface request form on December 9, 2022 to the Tech Focus Group. The initial request was for real-time, read-only access to CAD and AVL data on the production CAD server. This data would be sent to FUSUS for use in their software.

Tech Focus Group Review: On December 12, 2022, the Tech Focus group reviewed the request and an alternative option that would create a replica of the production database on a separate subnet. Using a replica database on a separate subnet mitigates any potential impact to the production CAD environment. The Tech Focus Group came to a consensus that due to the complexity of the system, and our experience of delays in CAD caused by direct connections to the production environment, the group recommended approving a interface to a replica only. A meeting was scheduled with Hexagon and FUSUS to review the recommendation.

A non-disclosure agreement was signed by FUSUS, at Hexagon’s request and a technical discovery meeting was scheduled for January 10, 2023.

The meeting on January 10 included the following:

- A review of the original request to interface directly with production CAD
- Connecting to a replica database on a separate subnet
- A review of the capabilities of Edge Frontier (a system used by Hexagon to provide CAD data to other applications)

The Tech Focus group members on the call made it clear to FUSUS that they were not comfortable with a direct connection to CAD. It was explained that our system was more complex than their other integrations and that we have experienced CAD slow downs from other systems querying the database that was unacceptable. The group discussed an Edge Frontier interface but felt that the time for developing and the potential cost would be prohibitive. Ultimately the group requested a quote from Hexagon to create a replica of the database. Hexagon gave a 45–60 day timeline to provide the quote for the replica.

Replica Quote: Hexagon provided the quote on March 13, 2023. The cost of the replica database was \$183,964.79. approximately \$8,500 in services and \$175,000 for Microsoft licenses. Hexagon advised that the license costs are from Microsoft and were essentially a passthrough. ETSB did not distribute this quote to all the parties, but instead requested Hexagon provide other options.

Hexagon provided three alternatives (in bold):

- **Executing the replica quote**
- **Use disaster recovery licensing from the RMS side of the system.**
ETSB Research: ETSB and County IT meet with Hexagon to review using the disaster recovery licenses from RMS. This option was deemed not viable because taking the secondary licenses from RMS would leave that system unacceptably vulnerable.
- **Implementing an Edge Frontier interface**
ETSB Research: ETSB and County IT staff requested Hexagon make available their Edge Frontier Engineers for a meeting with FUSUS and Tech Focus Staff.

Tech Focus Update: Tech Focus Group was provided an update on Monday April 2, 2023. The Tech Focus group requested Hexagon investigate an additional option, increasing the frequency of transferring data to the archive server to near-real time. Currently the Archive server is updated every 10 minutes. Hexagon does not recommend reducing the timeframe from every 10 minutes to near real time. They explained that the archive server is not a replication but a software sync between the two databases. Reducing the sync time would interfere with other processes.

Vendor Meet: On April 10, 2023; FUSUS, Oak Brook, Tech Focus Group, DuPage County Board Members, ETSB and Hexagon staff meet virtually to review available options. The group agreed to pursue an Edge Frontier interface to connect FUSUS with CAD data.

FUSUS Edge Frontier Interface Status 4/20/23:

Physical Appliance: ETSB staff provided network location information to FUSUS for their device. The next step is for FUSUS to configure their machine and deliver it to ETSB. Once onsite ETSB and FUSUS staff will need to test connectivity.

- Status: In Progress
- Owner: FUSUS/ETSB
- FUSUS advised the final configuration is dependent on the VLAN on 4/20/23.

Network Connectivity: FUSUS provided a networking data gathering sheet to ETSB. The next step is for ETSB to create a separate VLAN to host the FUSUS appliance and provide the Network information.

- Status: In Progress
- Owner: ETSB

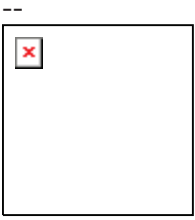

FUSUS Interface to Hexagon CAD – Quote # 2023—51188 – Cost: \$20,544.00

We, the undersigned, as three participating agencies, agree to share the above cost or \$6,848 for each agency. We further understand that as of June 22, 2023, there are other agencies expressing an interest in participating in the development of the interface and that the cost of the interface will be divided equally between those users who have signed on at the time of the invoice to reimburse ETSB, including any additional participants from the date of this Letter of Intent.


We understand that if our agencies are the only ones to sign a letter of intent and execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), then the three agencies listed below will each be liable for their share of the entire cost of the interface development. We further understand that once the cost of the interface has been invoiced, the division of the costs is final regardless of additional agencies joining. We understand that ETSB does not intend to invoice for the cost of the interface until the interface has been implemented and accepted as operational.

We understand that annual maintenance will be divided by the number of agencies currently using the interface at the time maintenance is invoiced each year. One Year of maintenance has been quoted at \$3,000.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: I move to approve Resolution R-2118 authorizing the Memorandum of Understanding between DuPage ETSB and the Village of Oak Brook for the Hexagon CAD Interface project which will allow for real time data to be imported in the FUSUS platform, and further authorizing the Village Manager to sign the maintenance and database access agreements.

Background/History:

The Village of Oak Brook entered into a contract with FUSUS, Real Time Crime Center software in December of 2022 becoming the first agency in DuPage County to implement this software. The police department has been working diligently to build the Oak Brook/FUSUS network and bring community partners onto the platform. The key component to auto generating real time camera feeds for Officers to view in the field is Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) integration. The police department is waiting on CAD integration for full FUSUS implementation and training of the entire staff. This integration piece has been a lengthy process as DuPage ETSB is unique in that every DuPage Police agency has one CAD vendor which is Hexagon. DuPage ETSB and Hexagon would not allow an outside vendor (FUSUS) to put a network appliance on their network fearing it would slow down production CAD data for the entire County. DuPage ETSB and Hexagon developed a solution to obtain this data through their Edge Frontier network which duplicates CAD data and provides necessary fields to FUSUS to populate cameras automatically with associated calls for service.

There are currently three DuPage County police agencies under contract with FUSUS being Oak Brook, Oak Brook Terrace and Wheaton. At least six other agencies are tracking this project and have expressed interest. The cost associated with the identified solution to CAD integration is \$20,544.00 with recurring maintenance costs of \$3,000. At this time, this cost is divided among the three committed police agencies at a cost of \$6,848.00 plus \$1,000.00 recurring maintenance costs for each agency. The recommended payment option is three equal payments with the first payment made one year after implementation

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Brook (hereinafter referred to as "Village") is a municipal corporation with authority provided for and granted pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code to exercise certain powers and perform certain functions pertaining to its local government and affairs;

WHEREAS, the Village upon approval of the Village President and Board of Trustees (collectively the "Corporate Authorities") may contract with another party pursuant to Illinois Statute;

WHEREAS, the County of DuPage, Illinois in collaboration with its Emergency Telephone System Board (ETSB), has implemented an integrated justice system known as DuPage Justice Information System (DuJIS) which will allow participating police and fire departments to exchange information with and between County's court and correctional entities;

WHEREAS, the County's Hexagon CAD system has replaced the ETSB's former Computer Aided Dispatch (DuJIS) system;

WHEREAS, the County's Hexagon CAD system has replaced the former incident Report Management system (LE RMS) and is used throughout the County;

WHEREAS, the Village has identified the need for access to the Hexagon CAD system for various applications, including, but not limited to, "real-time" applications for cameras, incident command, etc.;

WHEREAS, the ETSB requires that access to the Hexagon CAD system be facilitated through a proprietary interface (Edge Frontier (Xalt Interface)) ("hereinafter Edge Frontier") developed by Hexagon to access the Hexagon CAD system without impacting security and performance of the 9-1-1 system;

WHEREAS, The Village has reviewed materials prepared by the ETSB which detail Edge Frontier's estimated costs, organization, and functionality, as provided by the Memorandum of Understanding, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Village desires to utilize the Edge Frontier Interface to access Hexagon CAD; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to execute the attached Memorandum of Understanding directed to the State's Attorney and the Chairman of the ETSB as referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Brook, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section One – Recitals

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this resolution as legislative findings.

Section Two – Approval

The Village hereby approves the execution of the Memorandum of Understanding directed to the State’s Attorney and the Chairman of the ETSB, substantially in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof collectively as Exhibit A.

Section Three – Authorization and Direction

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A; and further, that the Village Clerk shall transmit copies of this Resolution to the State’s Attorney and the Chairman of the ETSB forthwith.

Section Four - Other Actions Authorized

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this resolution and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated herein, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

Section Five - Authorization of Expenditures

The cost associated with the identified solution to CAD integration is \$20,544.00 with recurring maintenance costs of \$3,000. At this time, this cost is divided among the three committed police agencies at a cost of \$6,848.00 plus \$1,000.00 recurring maintenance costs for each agency.

Section Six - Acts of Village Officials

That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officials of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this resolution are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

Section Seven – Effective Date

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Eight - Publication

This resolution shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

This is a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Emergency Telephone System Board of DuPage County (ETSB) and the Oak Brook Police Department the participating Agency governing the development of an interface and connection to the Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system and an application the agency(s) seeks to have the ability to retrieve CAD data. It shall cover the specific interface as defined in the Interface request form, completed by the agency(s) and recommended by the Tech Focus Group attached to this MOU:

I. Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (Agreement) between the parties is to formalize a usage agreement for the above listed interface connection to the ETSB CAD system and used by public safety service members within the ETSB 9-1-1 System service area.

Further, this Agreement between the parties is to formalize payment for an interface whose cost is the responsibility of the requesting agency(s) and not suitable for support with 9-1-1 surcharge funds.

II. Background

Phase 2 of the DuPage Justice Information System (DuJIS), additional applications and interfaces, has been evolving since “go live” in 2019. This MOU will be for Agencies that have requested interface connections to the Hexagon CAD system for applications that cannot be supported with 9-1-1 surcharge funds.

Access for “real-time” applications for cameras, incident command, etc. for all agencies must occur without impacting the primary mission of the CAD system: The handling of 9-1-1 calls and emergency dispatches.

The ETSB has had a policy in place since 2012 to address connections to the 9-1-1 system. This policy outlines the system requirements for connections and that each interface request will be reviewed by the Tech Focus Group to make a recommendation on the security and reliability of the submission. The Tech Focus Group has recommended that there should not be any direct connections to the production CAD system.

The current CAD system utilizes *Edge Frontier (Xalt Interface)*, which is designed to handle these types of interfaces. *Edge Frontier (Xalt Interface)* allows the applications to receive information without impacting the security and performance of the 9-1-1 System. An *Edge Frontier (Xalt Interface)* interface would be developed and maintained by Hexagon for all non-9-1-1 interfaces at the cost of the requesting agency.

III. Responsibilities of the ETSB

The ETSB agrees to make available the CAD system via an *Edge Frontier* (Xalt Interface) interface for its users, including the Agency, until or unless by mutual agreement of the users and ETSB, all parties opt to discontinue the interface.

The ETSB will provide the option of a time and material contract (Contract) for users for the development of the requested interface.

The ETSB will provide the Agency with an annual invoice for the cost of the Agency's portion of maintenance for the Interface. The annual invoice will be based on the Agency's portion of the total amount of maintenance as determined by the vendor.

IV. Responsibilities of the Agency

The Agency agrees to reimburse the cost of the interface as detailed in the Contract's scope of work for the interface detailed above through the execution of this MOU.

The Agency agrees to continue maintenance and reimburse ETSB annually for the cost of maintenance for the interface. Maintenance of the interface entitles the Agency initial service request review and support from ETSB and vendor support if ETSB staff cannot resolve a service issue at the first-tier level.

The Agency agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County of DuPage and the DuPage County ETSB, and all of its present, former and future officers, including board members, commissioners, employees, attorneys, agents and assigns from and against any and all losses, liabilities, damages, claims, demands, fines, penalties, causes of action, costs and expenses whatsoever, including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees and court costs, present or future, known or unknown, sounding in law or equity that arise out of or from or otherwise relate, directly or indirectly, to this Memorandum or its use of Edge Frontier (Xalt Interface) System to the extent authorized by law. Nothing in this MOU shall affect the DuPage County State's Attorney's status as the exclusive legal representative of DuPage County, including the ETSB. ETSB and the County of DuPage also do not waive any defenses, privileges, or immunities, including, but not limited to, the Illinois Local Governmental and Governmental Employees Tort Immunity Act 745 ILCS 10/2-101 *et seq.* due to indemnification.

The Agency agrees that it shall not sue, institute, cause to be instituted or permit to be instituted on its behalf, or by or on behalf of its past, present or future officials, officers, employees, attorneys, agents or assigns, any proceeding or other action with or before any local, state and/or federal agency, court or other tribunal, against the County of DuPage or the DuPage County ETSB, their board members, officers, commissioners, employees, attorneys, agents or assigns, arising out of, or from, or otherwise relating, directly or indirectly, to this Memorandum or its use of the Edge Frontier (Xalt Interface) System to the extent authorized by law.

V. Interface Time and Material Funding – Choose one

[] (Authorized Agency Initials) The Agency wishes to take advantage of a three-year, equal annual payment plan the first invoice to occur one year from the implementation and payment of the time and material cost to development as defined in the Scope of Work attached to this MOU.

Or

[] (Authorized Agency Initials) The Agency wishes to make one payment, invoiced no later than one year from the implementation and payment of the time and material cost to development as defined in the Scope of Work attached to this MOU.

VI. Further Agreements of the Parties

The parties agree that ETSB shall be the contracting party and authorized agent for maintenance and services on behalf of the users.

The parties agree that ETSB shall have the right to disconnect the interface, with notification, if the interface is determined to adversely impact the CAD system’s ability to function for its primary mission. Such notification shall be via email for documentation and made within a reasonable timeframe prior to disconnection. If exigent circumstances exist, notification shall be made as soon as practicable after disconnection.

The parties agree that this MOU shall be governed by the laws of the State of Illinois and that the venue for all disputes arising out of this MOU shall exclusively be in the Circuit Court for Eighteenth Judicial Circuit Court, Wheaton, Illinois.

VII. Term, Termination, and Modification of Agreement

This MOU shall become effective upon its execution by both parties and shall remain in effect until terminated, as provided herein.

The Agency may terminate its participation in this Memorandum of Understanding upon sixty (60) days notice to the ETSB upon payment of any outstanding costs and fees. All property of the core system shall remain the property of ETSB and DuPage County upon termination. Termination of this MOU constitutes disconnection of the interface unless mutually agreed upon in writing by both parties.
